Kudos to Stan Burns and Con Schmaucks who have brought this fine band up to such a high standard in such a short space of time.



Now a quintet, Sligo Jazz Project's very first "Band-in-Residence" returns a second year running. 14-Time Grammy-winning Pat Metheny Group bassist Steve Rodby, who won his 14th Grammy this year and New York drummer extraordinaire Adam Nussbaum, join forces with British guitarist Mike Walker, virtuoso pianist Gwilym Simcock and saxophonist Iain Dixon. Individually they have performed with some of the biggest names in the jazz world such as Pat Metheny, Tony Bennett and the Brecker Brothers. A week-long stint at Sligo Jazz Project's international summer school and festival is part of their European tour this year. Gwilym Simcock joins us straight off a world tour as pianist with Pat Metheny's new group. Expect a tight, passionate, inspirational, virtuosic performance from five wonderful musicians. Manden Express is a thrillingly explosive Dublin-based international band, fusing traditional and contemporary styles of West African music from the Mande Empire of what is now known as Mali, alongside infectious Afrobeat rhythms. Inspired by village, Wassalou (Oumou Sangare) styles and the explosion of new musical influences that merged with African music in the 1960's it blends Kamele n'goni harp, Kora, djembe, and drums with Electric bass and guitar to produce stomping grooves and hypnotic time patterns.



The septet is the only group of its type in Ireland, charged with rhythmic energy and weaving together a wealth of experience in African music and other styles like flamenco, jazz, funk and rock, with band members hailing from Guinea, Spain, Peru and Ireland. They have appeared at Bray Jazz Festival, Down With Jazz Festival, The Big Bang Festival, Electric Picnic, Body and Soul Festival and Africa Day amongst others and are a regular fixture on the Dublin scene.
